



# Bird-watching tours

from Sandur 2

There are two available routes. The tours take place in the afternoon between 4 PM and 7 PM, and in the evenings, but other arrangements can be made. The car takes 6 passengers, 2 at a minimum. For larger groups, an extra car will be provided.

A two hour trip with seal-spotting in Skjálfandaflijt, a drive to the pond Fifutjarnir, which is inhabited by various types of ducks, red throated diver, eider, and more, and a drive through a nesting area of the arctic tern, to lake Miklavatn which is inhabited by various types of ducks, the slavian grebe, and other types. **Price 4,500 IKR pr passenger (€30)**

A three hour trip with seal-spotting in Skjálfandaflijt, a drive through the nesting areas of the eider and the arctic tern, down to the sea, and along the beach to the mouth of Skjálfandaflijt. There one can experience great birdlife, eg. arctic tern, sea gulls, and kittiwake. Then we will drive to lake Miklavatn, which is inhabited by various types of ducks, the slavian grebe, and other types. **Price 5,500 IKR pr passenger (€36)**

Birds likely to be spotted: golden plover, ringed plover, redshank, purple sandpiper, oystercatcher, redwing, ptarmigan, eider, whimbrel, black-tailed godwit, arctic skua, great skua, black headed gull, common gull, lesser black backed gull, great black backed gull, arctic tern, kittiwake, wigeon, mallard, teal, long tailed duck, scaup, tufted duck, red-breasted merganser, red throated diver, slavian grebe, red-necked phalarope, and more.

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
